1. Child Situation (Family Situation, Health and School) and other optional subjects

Disakar is a active and smart boy with a happy smile on his face. He studies in the second standard at the Phulbondh School and appeared for exams and promoted to 3rd class for this year. He likes the subject oriya. His favourite teacher is Mr. Pitambar Bisoi. He likes the festival Chaitro Porab and to play cricket. During his holidays he is playing with his friends Mittu Naik and Jadu Naik. During holidays he collects mangos with friends and also helps his parents agriculture work. His future ambition is to become a teacher. He got education materials like notebook, 2 books, pencil and a pen. When he is in a good position he wants to give his parents Rs. 1000/- per month. He has 6 pairs of dresses and one of slippers. His demand to his parents is to get some sweets. His health status is normal and feels happy about his life.

The family are cultivating two times in a year. They are buying the seeds from Semiliguda market. They are cultivating paddy, suan, ragi, cucumber, dolicious, greens, beans and ginger. The family is using chemical fertilizer and also organic fertilizer like cow dung. They have a food security for 9 months. Their annual income is about Rs. 12000/- and grandfather gets old age pension about Rs. 300/- per month. They get drinking water from the water tank and have a mobile phone. The family has a BPL card, PDS facility and labour card. Due to extreme climatic conditions they are unable to produce more crops which hampering the family in food security.


2. Child/Family Involvement in Project Activities


The child is a member of Children Organisation and Children Movement for Climate Justice. Parents participate in CRPC, PO, WO and other village meetings. The family participates in family forestry program, they were supported with one mango and two papaya saplings. The family is protecting family forestry plants. The family comes under low carbon farming initiative which was initiated two years before. Family avails mobile health programme and treatment facility. Village has been supported with two sets of marker and weeder. Kia Jani, Soba Jani, Jimlo Jani and Talso Jani from the village has been attended a meeting to finalise package of Practices for paddy cultivation. 6 malnourished children have been provided with Nutrition Supplementation. The child has been provided tin box, school uniform and education materials.
